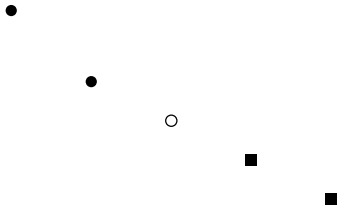

Google Search is an online search engine that allows you to easily find information on the internet. There are several ways to use Google Search to find relevant information, including:



Using keywords

Enter keywords into the search bar to find web pages containing those keywords.

Step 4: Click on search results Once you've performed your search, Google will display a list of relevant results based on your search terms. Click on a result to view the corresponding web page.

Step 5: Refine the search If you're not satisfied with the results of your search, you can refine your search by using different search terms or by using more specific search filters.
